AVL Playback Demonstration and Map Enhancements

This session will highlight some of the recent enhancements in Zuercher Mapping like map bookmarks, telephone extract searching, and the ability to start calls for service directly from a 911 call icon right on your map. We'll also showcase the new AVL playback functionality that can be added onto your system.

Booking Faster and Smarter

Zuercher Jail offers a lot of configuration options so you can tailor your system to the way you do bookings and intakes – or even use the system to improve the way you do them! This session will help you configure your intakes and bookings to collect all of the data you need while keeping the process streamlined. We'll explore intakes, bookings, various form and wizard configurations, and how suspending and staging your process can make it as efficient as possible.

CAD Configuration Options

This session will provide a refresher on some of the many configuration options Zuercher CAD offers to help you set up your system around the way you work. We'll demonstrate how you can configure your system to get the most out of features like CAD window templates, hot keys, and configurable commands.

Case Configuration Tips and Tools

Attend this session for some useful tips and tools for configuring your case reports. This session will demonstrate how to set up your system for your unique approval process and case dispositions. You'll learn more about print presets, how to create multiple report types, and how to change your forms and form requirements.

Custom Forms and Modules – Basic Skills
